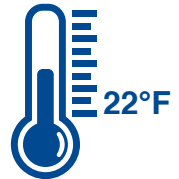


Cold Weather in February May Impact March Electric Bills

BPUB Electric Rates and Charges Will Not Change

• February Extreme Cold Temperatures

Your space heating equipment ran longer and at maximum capacity, causing you to use more electricity to keep your home warm during the 7 days of extreme cold weather.



• Compare Your February and March Bills

To see how the winter storm affected your bill, you can compare your March bill to your February bill. The electricity use in your March bill may be higher if it includes the days during the extreme cold weather.

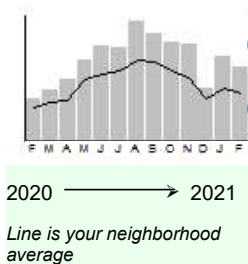

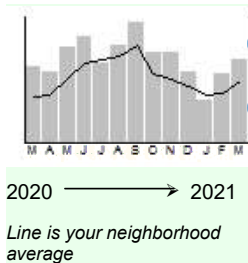

- 1 This is the amount of electricity used measured in kilowatt hours (kwh). Your electric bill is calculated based on the electricity used in a billing cycle. Compare your March bill to your February one to see if you used more electricity during that billing time.
- 2 This is the Energy Consumption Charge. The rate did not change, but the total charge may be higher if you used more electricity during the March billing cycle compared to the February cycle.
- 3 This is the Fuel and Energy Charge. The rate did not change, but the total charge may be higher in your March bill if you used more electricity than you did in previous billing cycles.
